

Guideline for suppliers of the maxon group for conformity assessments against RoHs/Reach

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1. Objective and Purpose

The guideline is intended to support maxon's cooperation with suppliers to demonstrate compliance with the legal requirements RoHS/REACH and to facilitate coordination between the partners.

2. Conformity assessment requirement

The conformity assessment shall contain at least the following content:

- **Manufacturer/supplier:** company name, address, contact person, telephone no. or e-mail address
- **Object:** Article No. and Name
- **Explicit mention of the legal regulation,** compliance with which is confirmed.

RoHS EU RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU (any exceptions must be explicitly mentioned).

Or

REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament, "Registration, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals (REACH) as interpreted by decision of the EU Court of Justice C-106/14 of 10 September 2015

List of ingredients subject to declaration with reference to the publication date of the "List of substances of very high concern eligible for authorisation" (<http://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>).

- **Release:** Signature, Name, Date, Function
